

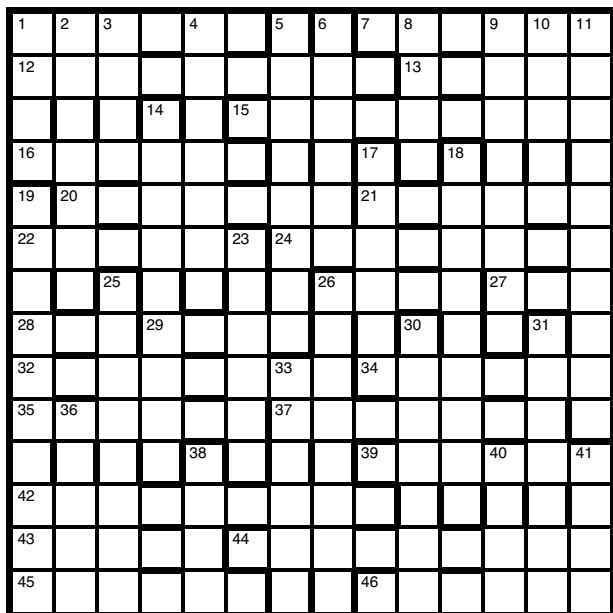
The unclued lights (two of one word and the remainder consisting of two separate components) can be arranged into two similar sequences.
